Yang Nai Wen @ Xi Yao (杨乃文, 字希尧), the primogenitor of the Yang family from Qiong Hai (琼海), Hainan Island (海南), China, was the 16th generation descendant of Yang Shi (杨时), the primogenitor of the Yang family in Fujian province.

迁徙海南省琼海市博鳌镇 杨乃文公世系脉络

海南琼海载德堂杨氏入琼始祖杨乃文公，字希尧，原籍福建兴化府莆田乌石山村，为闽房莆祖杨时（号龟山先生）十六世孙，进士杨惇仁之四子，杨允文次子、考功司员外郎杨有禄之孙，与兄杨乃圣（荆州刺史、长安太守）同登进士第，元至正十年庚寅（1350年）任广东舳舻司提举使，五年后携子杨跻谪居海南，住乐邑多乳坡（今琼海博鳌镇古流坡）。当时正处改朝换代战乱期。

第二代杨跻于明洪武十四年（1381），迁居会邑太平都（今福山镇）之茂亭村，子四。第三代杨蹄派系繁衍为最大支系，分为四房：长房入籍卜昌村、分三支，次房迁沙浦二岭村、分三支，三房入籍白土村、分七支，四房入籍鱸墩村、分三支。至2010年杨乃文支系繁衍海南已有653年历史，传26代近三万人，分居琼海、万宁、定安、屯昌、文昌、琼山、临高、儋县、崖县、琼中、澄迈、陵水、三亚、海口等14县市，225个村，还有众多后裔旅居马来西亚、新加坡、汶莱、泰国、日本、台湾、香港、美国、英国和加拿大等。

Yang Family Lineage of Yang Nai Wen Qiong Hai, Hainan, China

Yang Nai Wen @ Xi Yao (杨乃文，字希尧)，the primogenitor of the Yang family from Qiong Hai (琼海), Hainan Island (海南), China, was the 16th generation descendant of Yang Shi (杨时), the primogenitor of the Yang family in Fujian province, China, and the fourth son of Yang Dun Ren (杨惇仁). Yang Nai Wen, his brother Yang Nai Sheng, and his father were successful candidates in the highest imperial civil service examination (进士). In 1350, Yang Nai Wen assumed the duty of custom officer at Guang Dong (广东) Port authority. Five years later, Yang Nai Wen left the post to settle in Duo Lu Po, Le Yi, Hainan Island (currently known as Bo Ao) with his son, Yang Ji (杨跻). The reason for the move was not known, but it took place during the final years of the Yuan (Mongol) Dynasty, the warring period marking the transition to the Ming Dynasty.

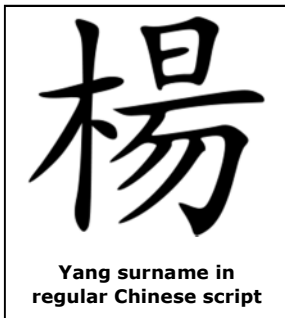
During the Ming Dynasty, in 1381, the second generation descendant, Yang Ji (杨跻) settled in Hui Yi (presently the township of Fu Tian, Qiong Hai). Of Yang Ji's four sons, only Yang Ti's (杨蹄) lineage had the greatest number of descendants. Yang Ti's subsequent lineages were divided into 4 branching as a result of migration to different places: the first branch settled in Bo Chang (卜昌村), subdivided into 3 sub-branches; the second branch settled in Sha Pu Er Ling (沙浦二岭村), subdivided into 3 sub-branches; the third branch settled in Bai Tu (白土村), subdivided into 7 sub-branches; the fourth branch settled Shan Dun in (鱸墩村), subdivided into 3 sub-branches.

Up until 2010, the genealogical lineage of Yang Nai Wen has evolved over 653 years, with 26 generations covering more than 30 thousand descendants distributed all over Hainan Island as well as overseas, notably Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Brunei, Japan, Taiwan, Hong Kong, U.S.A., England, and Canada.

三房次支派系十七世孙杨柞江公，谪居海南省琼海市上埇村，其十九世孙杨善和公于廿世纪初期(1920年)下南洋，最后迁徙马来西亚加影锡米山新村定居，其廿世孙杨庆鏊公则于二战后分迁马来西亚加影锡米山新村。

The 17th generation descendant Yang Zuo Jiang (杨柞江), from the 3rd Branch-2nd sub-Branch lineage, settled in Shang Yong village, Qiong Hai, Hainan. His 19th generation descendant Yang Shan He @ Yong Tong Woh (杨善和) left Hainan in early 1920 and finally settled in Sungai Chua, Kajang, Selangor, Malaysia. His 20th generation descendant Yang Qing Yun @ Yong Keng Khoon (杨庆鏊) left Hainan after World War II to settled in Sungai Chua too.

Introduction to Chinese Names: With some few exceptions, most common Chinese names are generally made up of three character: the first being the family surname, the second (middle) being the generation name, and the third (last) being the given name. Generation were developed through the use of a poem composed and decided upon by the family clan leaders and scholars. The number of characters in the poem constitutes the number of generations to be followed.



Yang (楊) is the *sixth most common Chinese surname* in China. Transliteration of Chinese family names into foreign languages poses a number of problems. The spelling of the Yang surname may thus take various other forms, depending on the spoken dialect used to pronounce it. Below are some of the more often encountered alternative Romanized spelling of the surname Yang 楊: Yeang / Young / Yeung, leong / Yeong / Yong / Jong / Yoong / Yung / Yeo / Yeoh / Yio / Eu / Io.

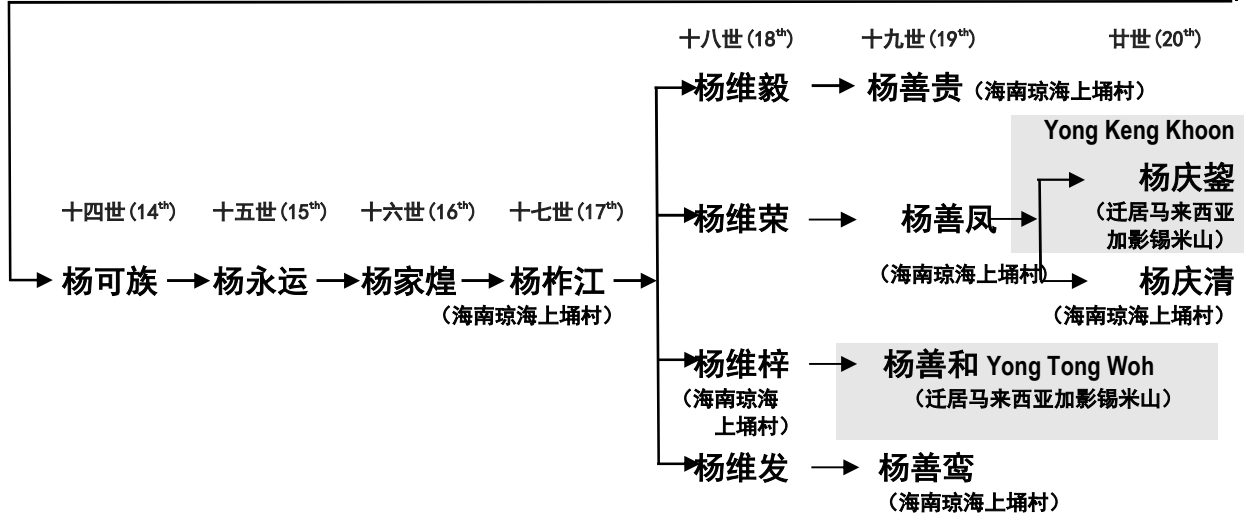
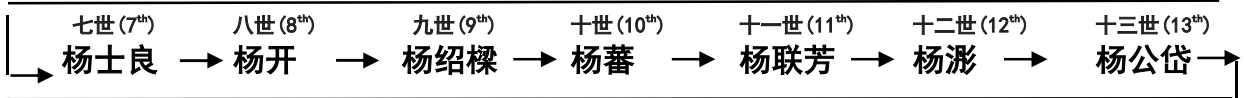
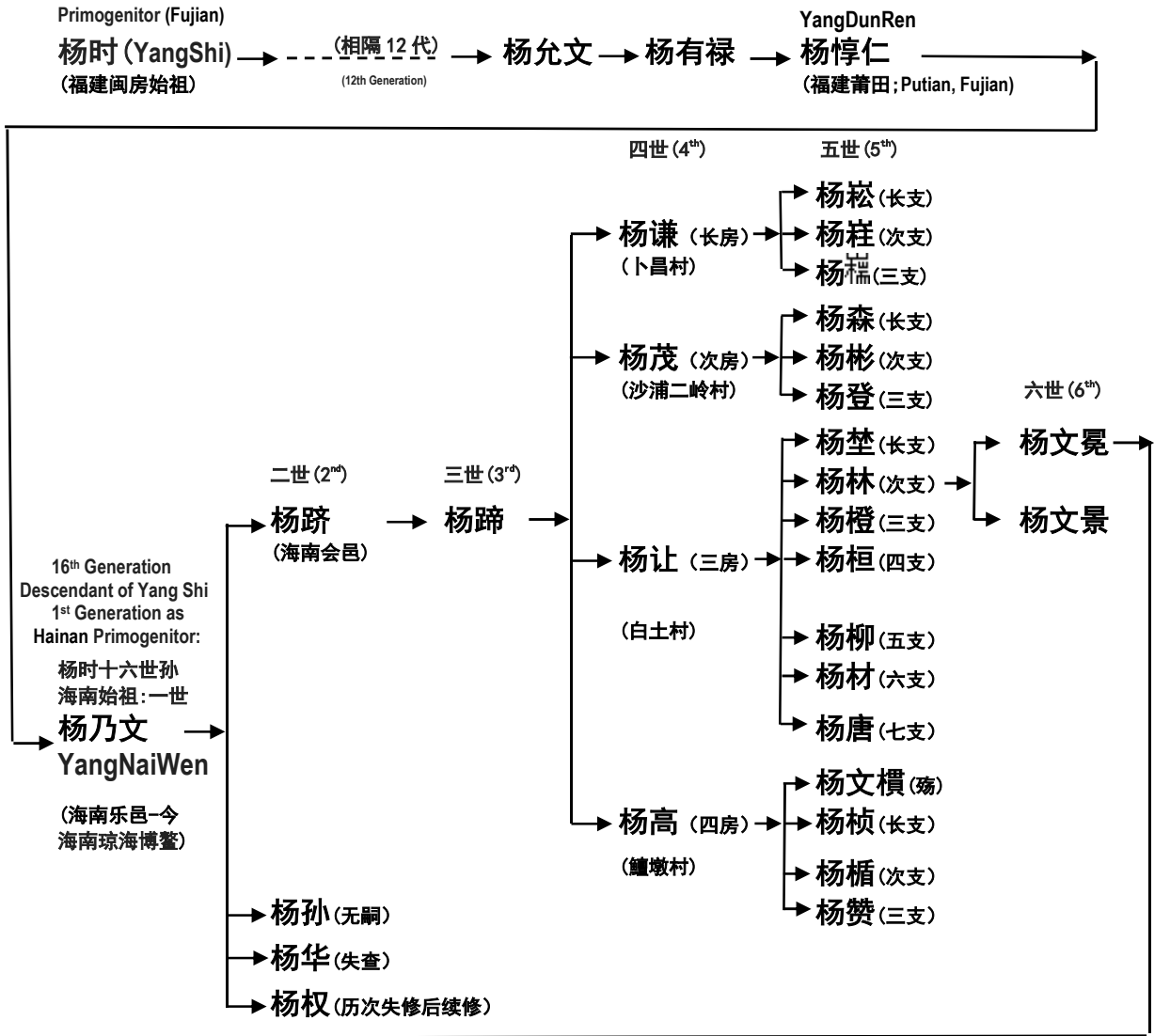

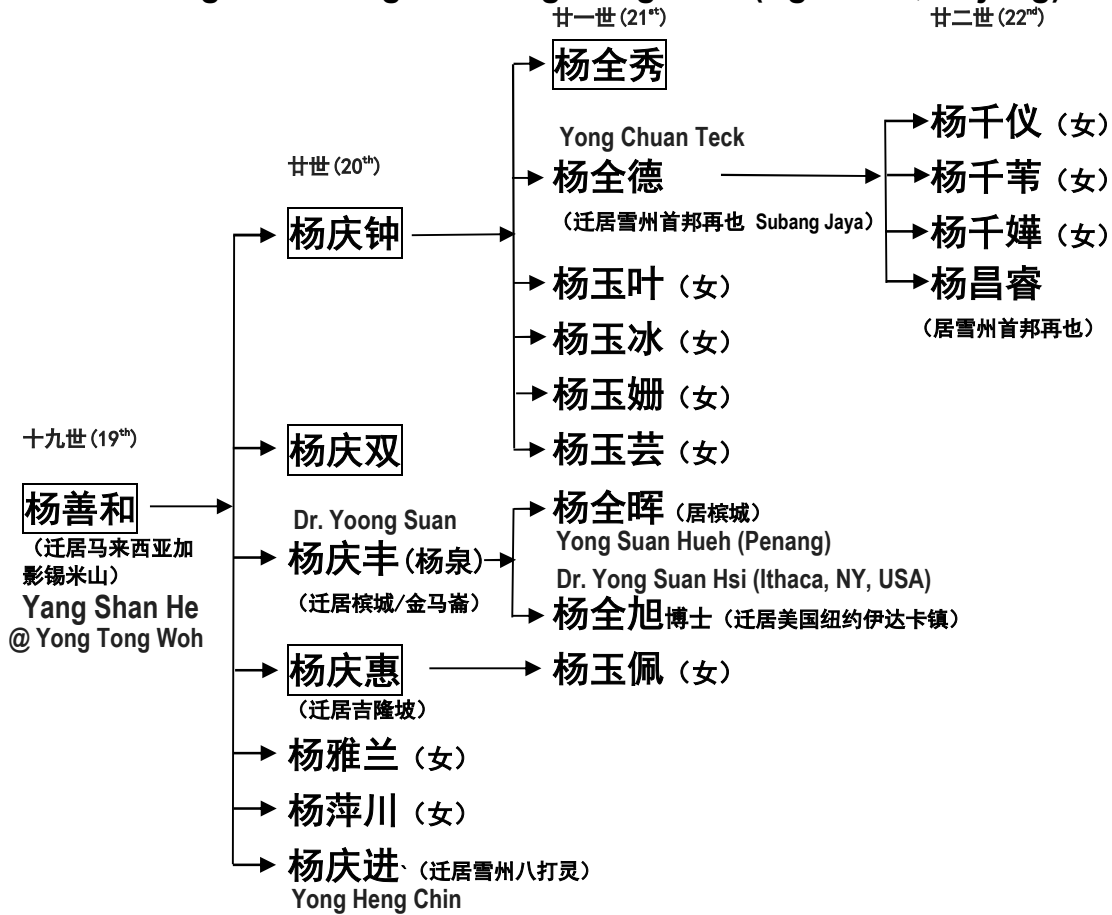
